



## Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa Frequently Asked Questions

Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa provides funding for programmes or projects delivering play, active recreation and sport experiences for tamariki and rangatahi. These may be new or already operating programmes/projects.

Priority groups include:

- Children & young people in higher deprivation communities (aged 5-18 years)
- Girls and young women (aged 5-24 years)
- Disabled children and young people (aged 5-18 years)

Dates for the first two Sport Taranaki rounds are:

### Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa Rounds 1 & 2

The first two rounds of Tū Manawa will have a cap of \$5000 per application to ensure the funding has the potential to reach more tamariki and rangatahi.

Below are some answers to questions that Sport Taranaki has been asked on Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa.

1. *Can organisations apply for more than one programme in one round, if both programmes equate to \$5000 in total?*
  - Yes
2. *Can I apply for more than one programme in a round if they fit under different physical domains e.g. sport, active recreation and play?*
  - Yes, but only a maximum of two applications per round, per organisation.
3. *Can organisations apply for equipment, clothing, travel, food and other miscellaneous costs?*
  - Yes but organisations will need to provide further information as to why this is a barrier to the programme. We will expect the following questions to be answered in a narrative.
    - How was this funded previously?
    - Who would miss out if funding was declined?

- *Would the programme still go ahead without this funding?*
- *How is this a barrier to your programme?*

*Schools would also be expected to provide information as to how they are using their direct KiwiSport fund to support / compliment this programme.*

4. *What is the maximum hourly rate to deliver community programmes?*
  - *As this funding is directed towards community programmes, rather than elite athletes, the maximum rate for coaching / delivery is \$40 per hour.*
5. *Can I apply for funding if I have an outstanding accountability report from KiwiSport?*
  - *Yes, but only for the Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa Fast Fund, Round 1.*
6. *Will there be any changes to the criteria / process for Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa after Fast Fast Round 1?*
  - *We are using this First Round to identify key trends / patterns and any unforeseen barriers to accessing this funding.*
