This is not intended for sportspeople who have passed through the Taranaki region but those that have developed here through school and/or club sport, have a community connection and would recognise themselves as someone from the Taranaki region.
- Please note that each award category has individual eligibility criteria which are listed with the category headings.

- Nominees may be nominated for multiple awards - please ensure you use a separate nomination form for each award.

Open to any coach who has made a significant contribution to a sport at a regional, national or international level within the achievement period.



## GAME OFFICIAL OF THE YEAR

Open to any game official who has made an outstanding contribution within the achievement period.



## VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Open to any volunteer who has made an outstanding contribution to the operation of a sport or active recreational club or organisation within the achievement period.



## CLUB OF THE YEAR AWARDS

Open to any outstanding sports and/or active recreational club which has performed with excellence in best practice. Nominees must have excelled in ALL of the following within the achievement period: Significant improvements to the club; the club's community impact; and their effectiveness managing members and volunteers in areas such as recruitment, professional development, facilities and finances.



## SERVICE TO SPORT AWARD

Open to any person who has made an outstanding contribution to sport and/or active recreation for more than 25 years. Nominations must be endorsed by a Regional Sports Organisation or similar body.
